to log in to myConnections

From any web browser visit:

- In the upper right hand corner, click on "myConnections Log in"
This is the Log in screen; we recommend that you bookmark this

- On initial log in, you will be prompted to set up multi-factor authentication. Follow the prompts on the screen to set this up – *it only takes a few minutes!*
In order to access the myConnections portal, you will need to complete this step first.
- Enter your username
- Enter your password
- You are now able to choose from the available services on the left

to add consent

- Capture the patient's signature on the provided consent form
- Log in to "myConnections",
Select "Patient Lookup"
- Enter the patient's last name and date of birth,
click "SUBMIT"
- Confirm the patient you are looking for
by clicking on the correct one
- Click "Add Consent", enter the selection
that the patient selected
- Do not use this process if you are sending
consents electronically
 - Check with your RHIO Administrator
if you are unsure

to look up patient/customer information

- Log in to "myConnections",
"Select Patient Lookup"
- Enter the patient's last name and date of birth,
click "SUBMIT"
- Confirm the patient you are looking for by
clicking on the correct one
- You will see the most recent 180 days of Data
- To see more data, on the LEFT of the screen,
click "Show all Data"
- To adjust your layout and see more
information, click "Configure Layout"
- To read progress notes and individual
encounters, use "Transcriptions"
- To open information, click on it to read more
 - To download information,
click "download report" at the top
 - You can also select several boxes, then
go to the right and click "download
